## **PRESS RELEASE**

City of Rensselaer clean up week is scheduled for the week of May 6 – 10, 2024. There will be some restrictions as to what the city crews will or will not pick up.

### **CITY CREWS WILL NOT PICK UP**

- General Contractor Materials
- Car Parts
- Chemicals, pesticides, paints & solvents
- Propane Tanks or any type of Fuel Tanks
- Oil of any type
- Red or Pink garbage bags
- Concrete or bricks
- Loose Trash (all small items must be put into bags)
- Barrels

### **CITY CREWS WILL PICK UP**

- Brush/Yard Waste
- Carpet & padding, must be rolled and taped or tied with string, no longer than 4 ft.
- Mattresses, box springs and furniture
- Appliances and Air Conditioners at a Charge of \$10.00 p/unit
- Vehicle Batteries
- Bagged trash (not to exceed 35lbs) or trash cans (not to exceed 50lbs)

The City will also pick up tires. The following fees apply:

Mid-Size Tires: \$10.00

Large Tires: \$15.00

Tractor Tires: \$25.00

All items for clean-up week should be placed by the curb for pickup on the day of your regular garbage route. Please separate items as to different types of materials (garbage, brush, yard waste, metal, appliances, etc.).

The City of Rensselaer will not tolerate scavengers. If you observe scavengers going through your trash please contact the City of Rensselaer Police Department at 219-866-7602. All scavengers will be ticketed and fined.
