Van Rensselaer St. Please note: since materials will be ordered in advance, we ask that you adhere to our registration deadline. Refunds cannot be guaranteed.

Tuesday Morning Camps

Little Chefs June 10, 17, 24 8-8:45 a.m. PreK - grade 1 \$10/day

Participants will learn how to prepare healthy snacks each day. We also take time enjoy our yummy treats!

Nature Play Date June 10, 17, 24 9-9:45 a.m. PreK- grade 1 \$10/day

This workshop involves exploring and observing nature in the park through active play.

Little Hands June 10, 17, 24 10-10:45 a.m. PreK- grade 1 \$10/day

Each day of camp is centered around a children's story. After the read aloud campers take part in an activity.

Wednesday Morning Camps

Fit Mornings June 11, 18, 25 8-9:30 a.m. Grades K- 5 \$10/day

This camp will provide a different physical activity each week including: hiking, yoga, lawn games, kiddie triathlon, etc.

Aquatics Club June 11, 18, 25 9:45-11 a.m. Grades 3-5 \$10/day

This camp is centered around activities in the pool. All participants should be able to swim without a floatation device.

Thursday Morning Camps

Donuts with Dinos June 12, 19, 26 8-8:45 a.m. PreK- grade 5 \$10/day

Campers will enjoy breakfast treats while having real life animal encounters.

Nature Explorers June 12, 19, 26 9-9:45 a.m. grades K-5 \$10/day

Participants will take part in hands-on activities each day that foster an appreciation of nature.

Art in the Park June 12, 19, 26 10-11 a.m. grades 2-5 \$10/day

We take part in various hands-on art activities centered around nature themes.

Week-long Camps

Kids' CAMP July 8, 9, 10 9-11 a.m. Grades 2-5 \$60 per person (includes t-shirt)

Participants will take part in crafts, games, snacks, outdoor play and have an overnight camp-out in the park on July 10. Campers will need to be dropped off for this portion of the camp at 6 p.m. on that day. Pick up time is 10 a.m. on July 11. Tents will be provided, Campers' supply list includes: sleeping bag, pillow, necessary toiletries, sleeping clothes, swimsuit and a towel.
