

**Meeting of the Rensselaer Community Recreational Development Corporation
held on Monday, 3 November 2025**

The Rensselaer Community Recreational Development Corporation monthly Meeting was held on Monday 3 November 2025 at Six o'clock pm (6 pm) at the Rensselaer City Hall Council Chambers located at 124 South Van Rensselaer Street, Rensselaer, Indiana; the same being duly advertised/notice of meeting previously.

President Michael L. Manis called the meeting to order with the following members being present: Sue Wing, Janice Deno, Jeff Rayburn, Stace Pickering, Ryan Ritter, Corey Heldak, Glen Allie and Michael L. Manis. Member Craig Hooker was absent. Eight RCRDC members being in attendance, a quorum was achieved for the meeting. Mayor Jeffrey S. Phillips and Heather Hall, Superintendent of Rensselaer Parks were also in attendance.

Supt. Hall presented her recommendations for Changes to various Park positions and explained that it was her desire to streamline the Department and make the Parks more efficient. A detailed plan of changes to remove the pool director position, increase head lifeguard pay, removal of RSST Swim Coaches from being a Park concern, and the reconfiguring of various Baseball/Softball positions were discussed. The Board voted unanimously to pursue additional information and to consider the recommendations further at the next meeting.


Supt. Hall further presented her vision to create increased summer employment opportunities by having youth/young adult positions that combined lifeguarding, Park Program facilitators, and Concessions.

Pres. Manis announced that he would be stepping down from the RCRDC and its Presidency effective for the next meeting (to allow for any corporate/tax filings as might be requested by Member Allie.)
