PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Rensselaer Water Department will be conducting its scheduled hydrant flushing & valve exercising program over the next couple of weeks.

Hydrant flushing is one of the most important routine maintenance activities a water system can perform. Flushing removes sediment and mineral buildup from the water mains, improves water clarity, taste & odor. Also, helps to verify that the hydrants are operating properly to protect our community in an emergency. Regular flushing helps extend the life of our water infrastructure, safeguarding the system that every home and business depends on every day.

During this time, residents may notice wet roadways, temporary fluctuations in water pressure or a slight discoloration of their water. This water remains safe, simply run your cold water tap for a few minutes until it clears up.
